The housekeeping and decoration of God's house should be done with sincere devotion and dignity in good taste. It is a team effort and each member contributes to making it run smoothly.

The rector is the head of the guild but he cannot do all that must be done in preparation for the services. The altar guild plays an important role and must be reliable and dependable. Ways to serve at God's altar include brass polishing, vacuuming, dusting, filling the oil candles, marking the Bible lessons, making sure the vestments are cleaned and pressed, and setting up the altars.
