At Church of the Holy Communion, we are committed to making a “joyful noise unto the Lord.” Hence, song is frequently interspersed throughout our entire service of worship. The children in the 2nd through 6th grades participate in a sacred music program (under the direction of Chris Hoyt) where they learn to sing the faith through musical settings of the Lord's Prayer, the Nicene Creed, and the Ten Commandments, as well as great hymns of the ages.
